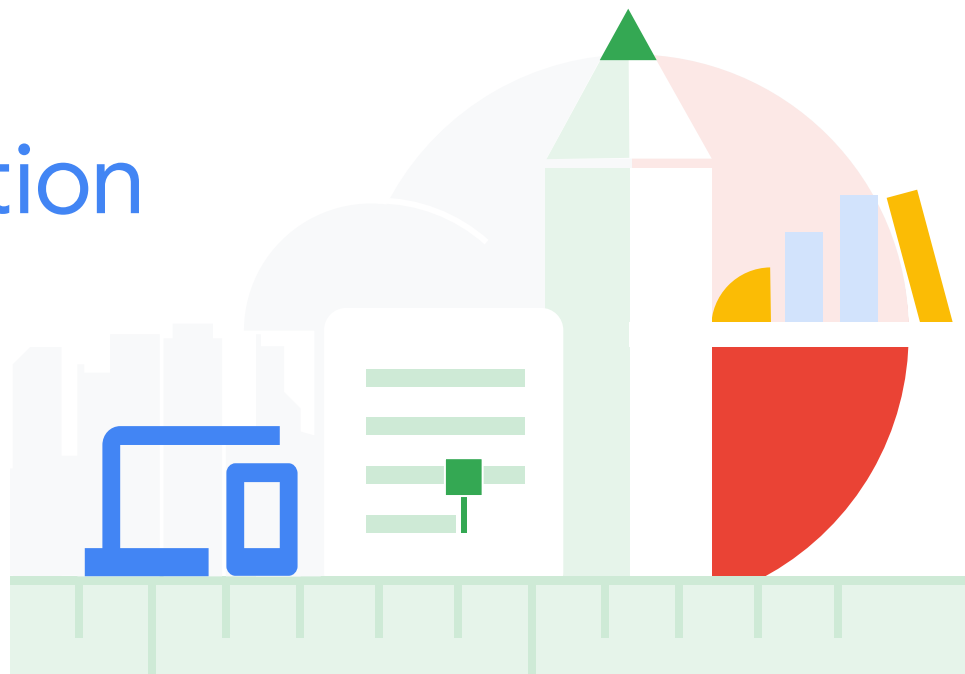


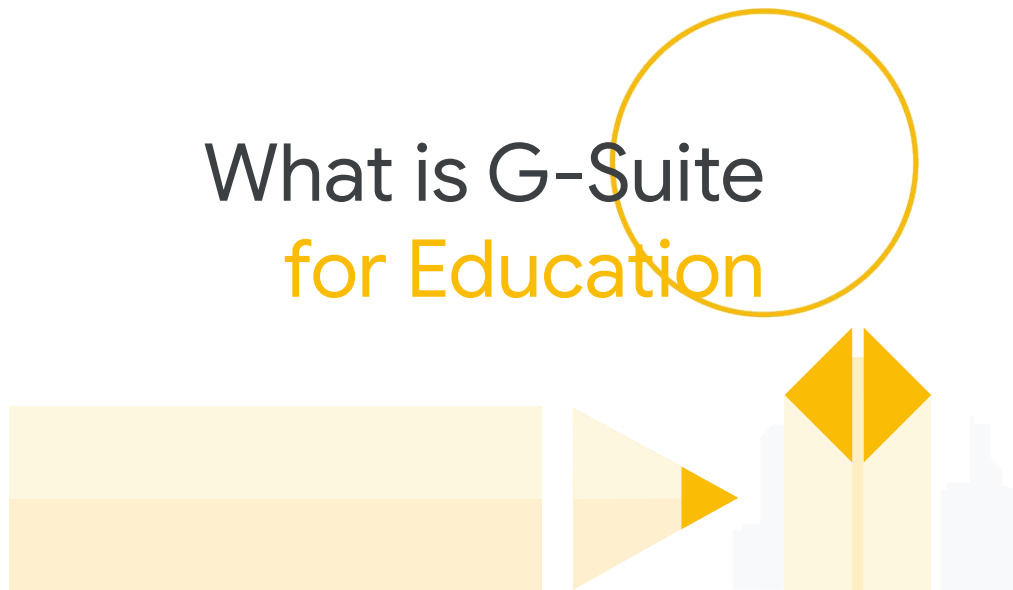

Google Suite for Education is a suite of tools that allows children and teachers to collaborate in real-time to create documents, presentations, surveys, spreadsheets and even websites.

Synchronous Learning

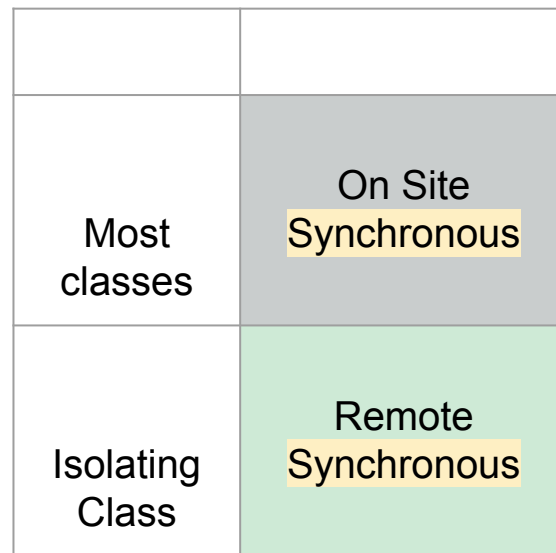
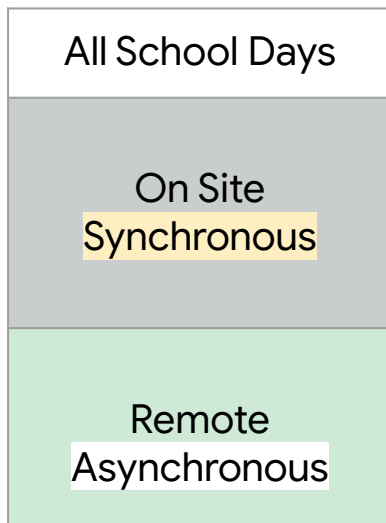
Teaching and learning occurs together, simultaneously.

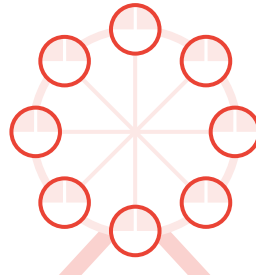
Why is Chalkhill Primary School using G-Suite?

Google Suite provides the ability for children and teachers to communicate, store files and collaborate on documents, spreadsheets, and presentations from school or home, all within a secure “closed campus” online environment.

It is important to remember an educational Google account is structured and managed differently to a ‘personal’ Google account.

We encourage parents to sit down with their children to look at the school work stored within their child's Google Drive and Classroom, just as we encourage pupils to share their work with their parents.

Will all my child's work be in their G-Suite?

The simple answer is no. G-Suite is used to enhance and develop the experience of the child. As such, teachers will decide when it is appropriate to use G-Suite to share work and when other methods are more appropriate.

Due to the age of our children, the majority of work will be completed in their writing books in class.

On occasions, children may complete a presentation or document online.

Google Drive	drive.google.com	Cloud storage for all file types including images, videos and audio files. Students have unlimited storage and can access their files from any device, anywhere they have an internet connection.	 Drive
Google Classroom	classroom.google.com	A blended learning platform that integrates Google Suite to allow teachers to assign and collect work from students. Classroom creates a paperless environment and saves time providing a way for teachers and students to easily communicate and stay organized. Parents can get update emails about the work going on in Google Classroom.	 Classroom
Google Slides	slides.google.com	Presentation tool that allows students to collaborate together on the same presentation and easily add images, videos and graphics to tell a story. Students can choose from templates or create their own slide format.	 Slides
Google Docs	docs.google.com	Word processing tool to allow students to create and edit text and paragraphs. Students can collaborate on the same document and teachers can easily provide feedback while students are working.	 Docs
Google Sheets	sheets.google.com	Spreadsheet tool for analysing, visualizing and charting data. Similar to the other G:Suite tools, students can easily share and collaborate in real-time.	 Sheets

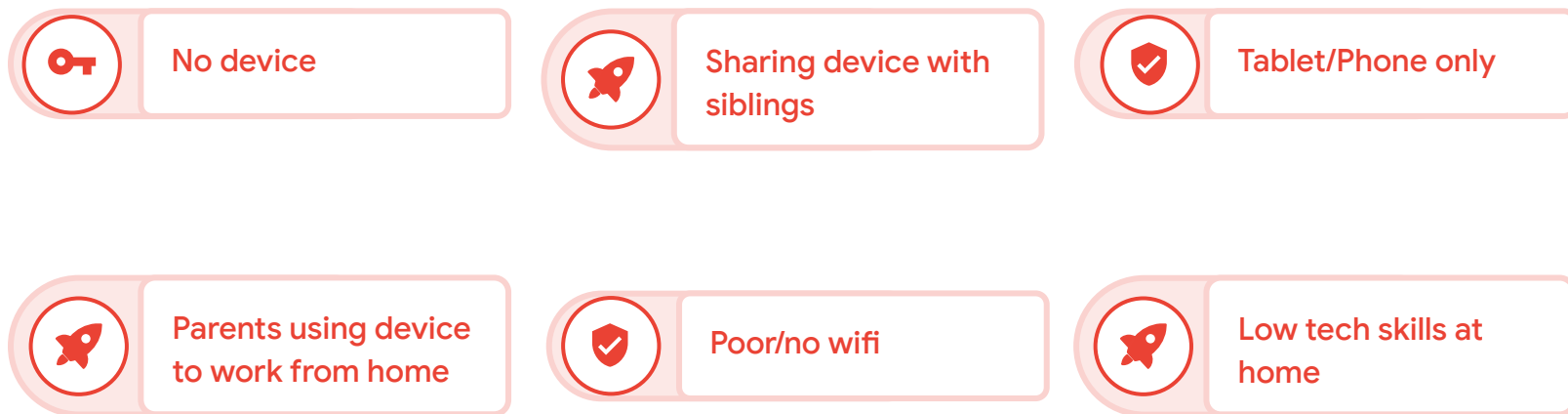

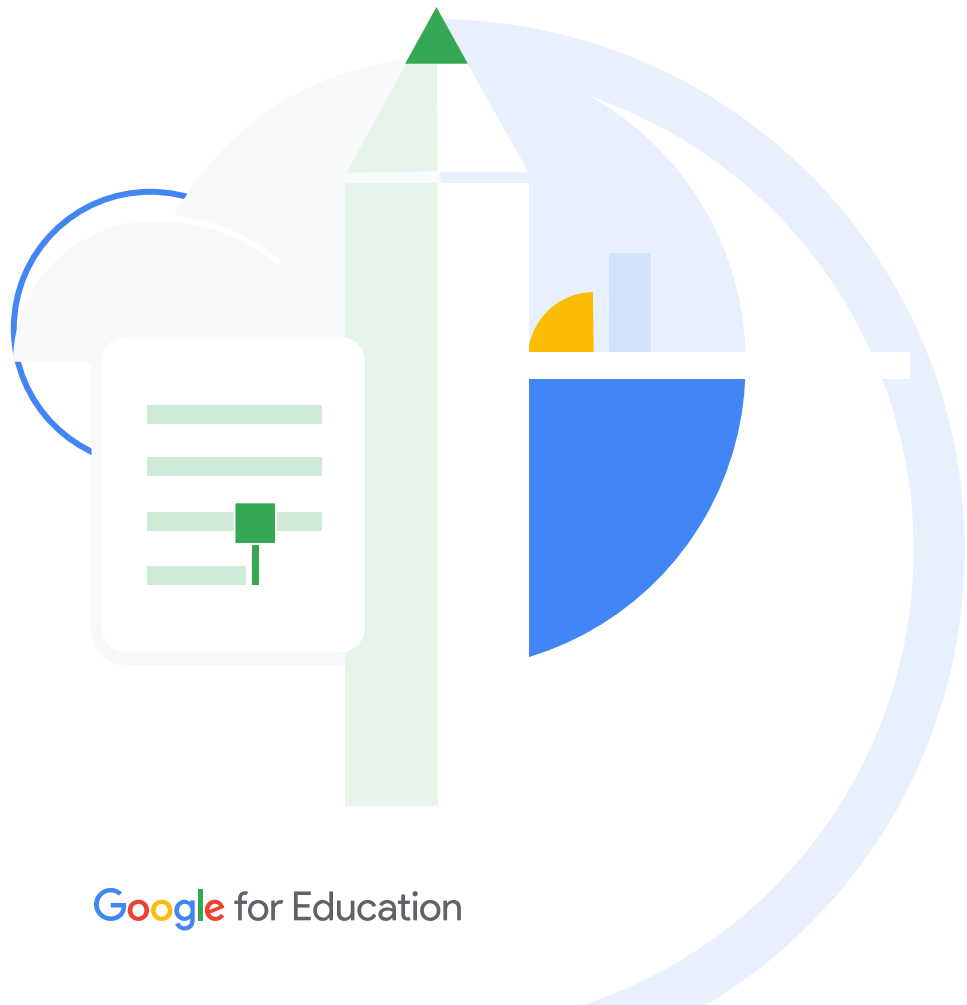
Potential challenges
