Dear Parents,

Yesterday I informed you that the school would be closed on Monday 7th to all pupils, except vulnerable pupils and the children of key workers.

This decision was taken by Brent Local Authority and the school Governing Body, in response to low staff numbers due to the impact of Covid 19.

Vulnerable pupils and the pupils of key workers have been contacted and attended school as normal today. All pupils are to be collected each day from the usual dismissal points.

Today Brent Local Authority have reviewed the situation and the feasibility of bringing in additional staff, to enable safe levels of support for pupils.

After a great deal of consideration and discussion, the decision has been taken to continue with the current arrangements. This means that all pupils, with the exception of the vulnerable pupils and key worker children, will continue with remote learning. Our remote learning document, is available on the school website to support you. Pupils' writing will be published on the Chalkhill Writers blog where we can celebrate good work at www.chalkhillwriters.com.

We recognise that this has been an extremely difficult time for families and this latest challenge has brought further disruption. However, school will be open until December 18th and we are available to support you as much as we can from 0800 to 1545 each day, with any questions that you may have.

Families with children in receipt of Free school meals, will receive a voucher for this week. The school office will contact you once these have been received from The Local Authority.

Place 2 Be one to one counselling will continue for pupils. Parents will be contacted this week.

Please contact the school office if you want to discuss key worker and vulnerable pupil provision.

The school and Local Authority will continue to monitor the staff numbers and provide you with a further update on Friday 11th December.
