### Reminders:

#### Attendance and Punctuality

School begins at **8:45am** and finishes at **3:15pm**. We expect your child to be in school **every day and on time**. Please make any appointments your child needs **outside of school hours**. Children need to be in school everyday if they are to succeed. Please ensure your child is picked up from the playground at 3:15. If you want your child to go home alone please send a letter to the class teacher.

#### School Uniform

- Please ensure that your child wears the correct school uniform **every day**. Every item of clothing must have their name written inside. Uniform is available for purchase from the office. Trainers are **not** part of school uniform (this includes black trainers).

#### P.E. Kits

- A complete P.E kit should be worn on the days that your child has P.E. 4B will have P.E on Wednesdays and Thursday. 4T will have P.E on Wednesdays and **(add second date)**. Please see the office to purchase P.E kits.

#### Reading Books

- **Children must read for at least 15 minutes every day**. New books will be uploaded on Bug Club on Mondays. Please ask the class teacher if your child would like additional books to be uploaded on Bug Club during the week.

#### Homework

- Homework will be uploaded onto Seesaw on **Thursdays**, which should be completed and returned on **Mondays**. It is important to return your child's completed homework on the day requested.
- **Spellings** will be chosen from the list of spellings handed out before the Easter holidays. The children will be tested on **Mondays**.
- In order for your child to succeed in maths, they need to learn their times tables and division facts up to 12 x 12 for quick recall. They should practise this daily. The children will be tested on **Fridays**.
