Please bring in a photo of your family this week.

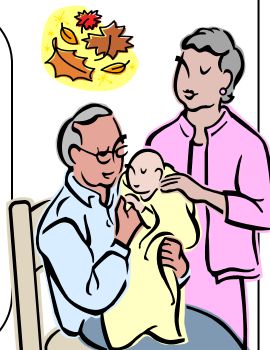
Please, remember the **50p fund** every Monday for cooking, arts and crafts and parties!
