DEAR PARENTS/CARERS,

To support your child in completing these tests, we will be posting video/ audio files and electronic versions of test papers will be uploaded on Seesaw as well as ClassDojo. Parents/carers are allowed to read the questions aloud to the pupils (except for the reading test) and provide a timed structure. At the end of each test, we will go through the answers via video links pupils can self-assess their practice test paper to evaluate how well they've done. We will also continue to go through any misconceptions from the practice tests papers throughout the week. Please ensure your child has a quiet space to complete this learning. For those who have already informed us, the printed copies can be collected from the school office on Monday 11th May from 8:30am. If you still need printed copies please inform the class teacher via ClassDojo and we will endeavor to do so as soon as possible.

As part of our commitment to your child's education, the school has been providing remote learning from home during school closure. Over the course of this academic year, Year 6 have worked diligently in preparation for their End of KS2 Assessments/ SATS tests which were due to take place during the week beginning Monday 11th May (next week). Due to school closure because of the current pandemic of COVID, the government have cancelled all formal testing within education, including SATS tests. However, we would still like to provide some sort of experience for our pupils and have prepared a 'Mock' SATS week where pupils will complete a practice tests papers, as they typically have per half term which contribute to their summative assessments.
